

**SLIGHT CHANGE IN
LOCAL ITINERARY**

**GRANITE REEF WILL NOT BE
VISITED EN ROUTE TO
ROOSEVELT.**

**Assignment of Passengers to Their
Respective Automobiles.**

The high water in the Verde river has necessitated a change in the itinerary of the Roosevelt party next Saturday, eliminating the visit to Granite Reef. It is impossible to cross the river at Granite Reef now, and doubtless will be on Saturday, so no effort will be made to carry out that part of the program.

Immediately on the arrival of Colonel Roosevelt and party, which it is expected will be at 9 o'clock Saturday morning, he will be met at the depot by automobile procession and the caravan will move toward Mesa City, crossing the Salt river via the Center street bridge, which it is promised will be near enough completion to be put in use on that day. If it is the desire of Colonel Roosevelt to see Granite Reef dam, which it is believed it will be, he can make the side trip from the Roosevelt road to the dam on the way back to Mesa City on Sunday.

The Phoenix people who are to accompany the official party to Roosevelt are all directed to assemble at the office of the Water Users' association at 8 o'clock Saturday morning, or an hour before the arrival of Colonel Roosevelt. That hour will be
